J. Kol studied economics at the Erasmus University in Rotterdam. He graduated cum laude in 1973 and got his Ph.D. cum laude at Erasmus University in 1988. His Ph.D. thesis was on 'The Measurement of Intra-Industry Trade'.

At the Centre for Development Planning he lectured on Quantitative Methods, Economic Development, and Project Appraisal. In research he assisted among others Prof. J. Tinbergen.

From 1989-1999 he has been co-ordinator of the masters programme 'The Economics of European Integration', a two-year masters programme on economic integration among countries and the internationalisation of firms. Within this masters programme Dr. Kol lectured on 'The Economics of Integration', 'Economic Policies of the EU', 'The European Union in the World Economy', and 'The International Firm and Economic Integration'.

Dr. Kol has published books and articles mainly on international economic relations and economic integration, among which, articles in the Journal of International Economics, Weltwirtschaftliches Archiv, European Economic Review, etc. He also published articles in newspapers and made contributions to radio- and TV-programmes on economic integration in Europe and international economic relations, the WTO and the Common Agricultural Policy.

He has lectured extensively in MBA-programmes in many countries; the topics were mainly on business environment, economic policies and economic regulation (EU and elsewhere), international trade and investment, and international competitiveness.

He was professor in the Economics of European Integration at Westminster University in London. He has been a visiting professor at the Hebrew University in Jerusalem and research fellow at the Free University (Brussels), Cornell University (Ithaca, USA), the World Bank (Washington D.C.) etc.

He has been a consultant to the World Bank, the OECD, the European Commission and other institutions, and to the governments of Indonesia, Latvia, the Netherlands etc.
