J.T. (Tom) Cain is a professor emeritus of electrical and computer engineering at the University of Pittsburgh. He led the effort to establish the Computing Sciences Accreditation Board (CSAB) and is a past president. He also served ABET as a program evaluator and as an alternate IEEE representative to the ABET Board of Directors. He is a past chair of the IEEE Educational Activities Board Accreditation Policy Council and Committee on Global Accreditation Activities. He helped establish and is a member of the Board of Directors of the Instituto de Calidad en Acreditación de las Carreras de Ingeniería y Tecnología (ICACIT) the accrediting body for engineering, computing and technology programs in Peru.

He is a past president of the IEEE, a Life Fellow of the IEEE, and a Fellow of CSAB.
